## General Rules

1. TDA rules apply to all Venetian Poker Room tournaments.
2. Must be 21+ years of age and have a Grazie card to participate.
3. Ten (10) minute break at the completion of levels 3, 6, and 12. There will be a thirty (30) minute dinner break after level nine (9). On Day 1A, play will continue until we are down to approximately 11% of the field, or 15 levels have been played. Day 1B and 1C will stop at exactly the same spot, in accord with the tournament clock, that Day 1A ended. Day Two will resume at 11am combining all remaining players from 1A, 1B, and 1C and will continue until a winner has been declared.
4. Management reserves the right to cancel or change tournament.
5. Winners will be paid in casino chips.
6. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to new IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
7. \$600 Buy-In starts with 20,000 in chips. Each level is forty (40) minutes.
8. \$55 of the \$600 Buy-In will be withheld for Entry Fee. \$30 of the \$600 Buy-In will be withheld for Staff Fee. \$515 of each \$600 buy in will form the prize pool.
9. Registration and Re-Entries allowed for the first six (6) levels and through the break. Any player who plays Day 1A may also play Day 1B or 1C regardless if they busted or still remain in the tournament. After Day 1C, if a player has chips remaining from Day 1A, Day 1B, or Day 1C, only the greater chip stack will move forward to Day 2. The lesser of the chip stacks shall be removed from play.
10. A prize pool of \$200,000 is guaranteed by the Venetian Poker Room.
11. The tournament prize pool disbursement, as set forth herein, may be modified upon unanimous written agreement of all tournament players still involved in the tournament.
12. Late entries do not have to post or wait for the Big Blind to play a hand.
