General Rules

- 1. TDA rules apply to all Venetian Poker Room tournaments.
- 2. Must be 21+ years of age and have a Grazie card to play.
- 3. Fifteen (15) minute break at the completion of every four (4) levels on Day 1. On Day 1A, 1B, and 1C, play will continue until we are down to 5% of the field. Day 2 will resume at 12pm combining all remaining players from Day 1A, 1B, and 1C and continue until a winner has been declared. The Day 2 clock will start at the earliest time that a Day 1 flight ended.
- 4. Management reserves the right to cancel or change tournament.
- 5. Winners will be paid in casino chips.
- 6. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to new IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount)
- 7. \$250 Buy-In starts with 15,000 chips. Day 1 is thirty (30) minutes. Day 2 is forty (40) minutes.
- \$30 of \$250 Buy-In will be withheld for Entry Fee. \$15 of \$250 Buy-In will be withheld for Staff Fee. The prize pool will
 consist of \$205 of every \$250 Buy In.
- 9. Registration and Re- Entry is allowed for the first eight (8) levels and through the break. Any player who plays and bags chips may not enter another Day 1. Any player who does will not be entitled to a refund of any buy in's made after bagging chips or any prize money that may be awarded due to the additional buy in.
- 10. 10% of each Day 1 starting field will be awarded prize money as listed here: 10% = \$400, 9% = \$500, 8% = \$600, 7% = \$700 and 6% = \$800. The Final 5% of each Day 1 starting field will bag chips and return for Day 2 with a minimum payout of \$1,000.
- 11. A prize pool of \$150,000 is guaranteed by the Venetian Poker Room.
- The tournament prize pool disbursement, as set forth herein, may be modified upon unanimous written agreement of Management and of all tournament players still involved in the tournament.
- 13. Late entries will be dealt in immediately.
