General Rules

- 1. TDA rules apply to all Venetian Poker Room tournaments.
- 2. Must be 21+ years of age and have a Grazie card to participate.
- 3. Fifteen (15) minute break at the completion of every two levels. On Day 1, play will continue until nine (9) levels have been played. Day 2 will resume at 2:00pm with all remaining players and will continue until eight (8) levels have been played. Day 3 will resume at 2:00pm and will continue until eight (8) levels have been played. Day 4 will resume at 2:00pm and continue until a winner has been declared.
- 4. Management reserves the right to cancel or change tournament.
- 5. Winners may choose to be paid in casino chips or cash.
- Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to new IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042s forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
- \$3,500 Buy-In starts with 40,000 in chips. Each level is sixty (60) minutes. Heads Up at the Final Table will have thirty (30) minute levels.
 \$225 of each \$3,500 Buy-In will be withheld for Entry Fee. \$125 of each \$3,500 Buy-In will be withheld for Staff Fee. The prize pool will

- 10. A total prize pool of 2,000,000 is guaranteed by the Venetian Poker Room.
- 11. In addition to receiving the tournament prize pool payout, the winner of this event shall be awarded a custom one of a kind Championship Pendant (\$3,500 retail value) designed and provided by Steve Soffa Enterprises, LLC (Championship Pendant). No substitution or cash redemption of Championship Pendant is permitted. The Championship Pendant is not funded by the tournament prize pool.
- 12. The tournament prize pool disbursement, as set forth herein, may be modified upon unanimous written agreement of management and of all tournament players still involved in the tournament.
- 13. Late Entries will be dealt in immediately.
