1. TDA rules apply to all Venetian Poker Room poker tournaments.
2. Must be 21+ years of age and have a Venetian Rewards card to participate.
3. Management reserves the right to cancel or change tournament.
4. Winners may choose to be paid in casino chips or cash.
5. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
6. \$130 of the \$1,100 Buy-In is withheld for house fees (Rake + Staff). The prize pool consists of \$970 of every \$1,100 Buy In.
7. All players will Ante every hand, and once all players receive a starting hand, action will proceed to the flop and normal betting procedures will follow from there. The minimum bet is equal to the size of the Ante and maximum bet allowed is equal to the size of the pot.
8. The button will move every hand and action will always start left of the button on the flop.
9. The highest hand shown for the top board and the highest hand shown for the bottom board will split the pot with any odd chips going to the top board winner.
10. This event will play eight (8) handed and pay 12.5% of the field.
11. When balancing tables, a High Card will be used to determine the player who moves to the unbalanced table.
12. The tournament prize pool disbursement, as set forth herein, may be modified upon unanimous written agreement of management and of all tournament players still involved in the tournament.
13. All pre-registered stacks will be in play at the start of the event.
